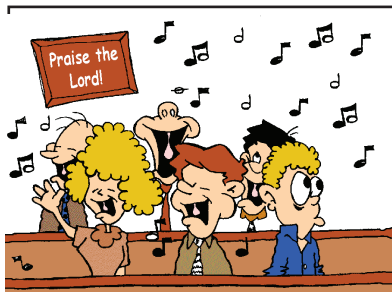

A few months back I was asked to make a list of the “one another” passages in the New Testament. Looking at only the passages that talk about how to treat one another I came up with 33 scriptures. There was another that speaks of the negative ways people can treat one another causing the reader to think of the positive ways we are to act.

Jesus summed up the whole codex of law with two basic thoughts, love God with your whole being and love your neighbor as yourself. These one another passages can be boiled down to that second thought of loving one another. If we have true love for one another, then all the other instructions will take care of themselves such as honor, live in harmony, accept, serve, bear with, etc.

Knowing that is how we are to treat all people, then it is a small thing to honor, respect, hold in high regard, remember, imitate, trust, and support elders who are serving the congregation

Some have an unhealthy view of what elders do and when an elder doesn't measure up to their picture they wage an unholy war against them. They treat that elder like dirt. Never is that appropriate. Also we are to make it a pleasure for the elders to serve, some wart and badger trying to get their way making an elder dread a phone call or visit from that individual. Often this person thinks they have a noble reason for their negative spirit, but it is absolutely contrary to how we should treat anyone and especially an elder.

Examine your experience with elders and think of how they were treated. Were you a part of making their job pleasurable or did you make it difficult? Think about it.
