We started a study in 1 Timothy some time back and put it on pause for most of December. We are going to get back into that study next week. Today we will lay some groundwork for the third chapter of 1 Timothy, particularly verses 1-7, as we begin to talk about elders. I do not claim to have the wisdom to answer all questions that may arise over this subject. There are many differing thoughts about who elders are, what they do, and a whole lot of variation when it comes to discussion of the qualities (qualifications) of elders. So there is a lot we will be looking at the next few weeks from scripture to sort out facts from fiction and opinion. I hope you listen with your Berean ears that will take what is said and search the scriptures to see if what is said is true. All we want to accept and bind on each other is what God has bound. In areas that are matters of preference (Paul would call them "disputable matters," Romans 14:1), we want what is consistent with what God has revealed, and that with plenty of grace toward each other, especially when we do have differences in the realm of opinion. May the Lord bless our study.
