- I. DEACONS DEFINED
 - A. Used 29x in NT
 - B. “One who waits at table”
- II. SELECTION OF DEACONS
 - A. 1 Timothy 3:8-10, 12-13
 1. Not told specifically what service they were rendering.
 2. We are told what they need to be.
 - a. worthy of respect
 - b. sincere
 - c. in indulging in much wine
 - d. not pursuing dishonest gain
 - e. keeps hold of the deep truths
 - f. be tested
 - g. husband of one wife
 3. Benefits
 - a. gain and excellent standing
 - b. give great assurance in their faith
 4. Why? Nature of their work demands it
 - B. Acts 6:1-7
 1. Not specifically called anything
 - a. v. 3 apostles saw their work as wrapped up in the proclamation of the word.
 - b. someone else could “serve tables” (verb form of the word deacon)
 2. What did they need to be?
 - a. full of the Holy Spirit
