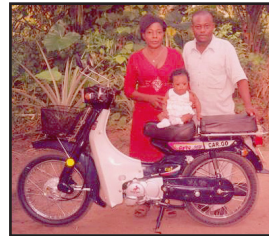
## 80th Birthday Celebration
